New Local Pharmacist Joins MRH&C Team

If you happen to see Charlie Tisdall's familiar smiling face at MRH&C, you'll notice she's wearing an employee badge. That's because the 2018 Selby Area High School grad recently completed her Doctor of Pharmacy Degree, from South Dakota State University, and returned to Mobridge as MRH&C's new Clinical Pharmacist.

"Pharmacists get to help patients in ways that aren't always seen by the public," Dr. Tisdall said. "Clinical Pharmacist is a new role here. I work directly with patients who are admitted to the hospital, helping review their medication lists and talking to their providers about what they're taking and why. Before patients are discharged, I go over their medications list with them again and talk about what each prescription is, what it's for, when to take it, etc. I love the patient interaction, and I also love knowing that I'm helping improve patient outcomes."

Dr. Lee Cordell is MRH&C's Director of Pharmacy. "Charlie is already making a big difference in the lives of our patients," he said. "We're so glad to add a Clinical Pharmacist to our team." The MRH&C pharmacy staff also includes one Certified Pharmacy Technician and a second technician earning certification.

Dr. Tisdall is just one of the exciting new additions to the MRH&C Pharmacy. A new compounding room—part of the hospital's recent addition—has been built to allow the pharmacists to prepare on-site hazardous medications, such as chemotherapy drugs. After earning certification, likely by the end of this year, the pharmacy will be ready to provide additional specialty medications to infusion nurses in the adjacent new infusion suite. Soon, this will mean that local patients can receive many chemotherapy infusion treatments, as well as other infusions, right here.



Coming from a much larger health system, Dr. Harper was impressed that the MRH&C surgical team, facilities, and equipment are all top-notch.

Dr. Harper and his wife, Jennifer, have purchased a home in Mobridge and will spend much of the year here. They will also maintain their home in Opelika, Alabama—just down the road from where their two sons attend Auburn University.

"I've been to South Dakota pheasant hunting for the past 23 years," Dr. Harper said. "So I know the people. Mobridge is a great community. We're enjoying getting to know folks in church and at the hospital. And the commitment to high quality surgical care at MRH&C is outstanding. It's exciting to be part of a surgical department in a small town that is so excellent and focused on continuous improvement. I came from a 315-bed hospital, and it wasn't as nice, spacious, and well-equipped as this facility."

By winter, Drs. Harper and Lawrence will be operating in MRH's new Surgical Services suite-part of MRH&C's expansion and remodel project. "Our whole surgical department will be under one umbrella," said Robyn Olson, MRH&C's OR Director. "We'll have preop, same-day surgery, the OR, and recovery areas all in one place, fully remodeled and newly equipped. This allows for better efficiency and higher quality of care."

"We are investing in equipment and facilities to ensure that our team has what it needs to perform at their best," said John J. Ayoub, MRH&C Chief Executive Officer. "We want to guarantee the facilities are supporting the good work being done by our people and not make our team work harder to overcome their environment."

In addition to Dr. Harper, MRH has hired additional surgical support staff, nurses, and certified nurse anesthetists to fully staff the new facilities.

"We're doing more procedures all the time," Olson said, "including more complex cases, such as knee and ankle arthroscopies. I want the community to know that we're capable of doing a lot of things right here in Mobridge. If you need a surgical procedure and you're not sure if it's offered at MRH&C, call and ask. You might be surprised."

"We are very excited to have Dr. Clay Harper join our medical staff," Ayoub said. "He is an exceptional surgeon, and he and his wife are delightful people! MRH&C is constantly looking to add phenomenal individuals to our already fantastic team."

Specialty Surgeries at MRH

Specialist surgeons work in residence at MRH once or twice monthly. The following is a sampling of the types of specialty procedures we do here.

- - ENT-tonsillectomy, adenoidectomy, ear tubes. nose bleed cauterization
 - **Ophthalmology**—cataract surgery, minor eyelid procedures, YAG laser capsulotomy
- - Orthopedics/Podiatry-knee and ankle arthroscopy, bunionectomy, hammer toe repair, carpal tunnel release, ulnar nerve decompression
